## Code of Conduct for Players

- Play for the fun of it, not just to please your parents or coach.
- Play by the laws of the game.
- Never argue with or complain about referee's calls or decisions.
- Control your temper, most of all resist the temptation to retaliate when you feel you have been wronged.
- Concentrate on playing soccer to the best of your ability. Work equally as hard for your team as for yourself.
- Be a good sport by cheering and supporting all good plays by your teammates.
- Do not criticize and condemn mistakes made by teammates.
- Treat all players, as you would like to be treated.
- Remember that the goals of the game are to have fun, improve your skills and feel good.
- Youth players must understand and accept that the Club has a **"zero tolerance"** policy for tobacco, alcohol and drug use.
- Do not be a show-off or a ball hog; soccer is above all a team game.

## Code of Ethics for Parents

- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches and officials at every game, practice or tournament.
- I will place the emotional and physical well being of the youth players ahead of any personal desire to win.
- I will insist that my child play in a safe and healthy environment
- I will provide support for coaches and officials working with my child to provide a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
- I will demand a drug, alcohol and tobacco free sports environment for my child and agree to assist by refraining from their use at all youth sporting events.
- I will remember that the game is for the young players not the adults.
- I will do my best to make youth sports fun for my child.
- My child and I will treat other players, coaches, fans and officials with respect regardless of race, gender, colour, religion or athletic ability.
- I will promise to help my child enjoy the youth sporting experience by supporting the team in any way I am capable such as coaching, providing transportation, helping with equipment etc.
- I will require that my child's coach be trained in the responsibilities of being a youth soccer coach and that the coach agrees with the Code of Ethics.
- I will do everything in my power to assist in the implementation of the parent's Code of Ethics.
